



COOKIE POLICY

This website uses cookies to improve your experience while browsing the web. Some of them are essential for the basic functioning of the web, and are therefore stored on your computer. We also use third-party cookies such as Google that help us analyze and understand how users browse the web

1. What are cookies?

They are files that are downloaded to the user's computer, smartphone or tablet when accessing a website and allow the owner of that page to store or retrieve certain information about multiple variables, such as; the number of times the page has been visited by the user, guarantee the user's session while browsing the page, etc.

2. Type of cookies

Below we offer information about the type of cookies generally used and the purpose of them:

2.1. Types of cookies depending on the entity that manages them

Depending on the entity that manages the computer or domain from which cookies are sent and treats the data obtained, we can distinguish:

- **Own cookies:** These are those that are sent to the user's terminal equipment from this Website.
- **Third-party cookies:** These are those that are sent to the user's terminal equipment from a computer or domain that is not managed by the publisher, but by another entity that processes the data obtained through cookies, such as www.google.com.

2.2. Types of cookies depending on the period of time they remain activated on the terminal equipment

- **Session cookies:** These are a type of cookies designed to collect and store data while the user accesses a website. As the name implies, these cookies are stored on your terminal until the end of the user's browsing session.
- **Persistent cookies:** They are a type of cookies in which the data are still stored in the terminal and can be accessed and processed for a period defined by the person responsible for the cookie.

2.3. Types of cookies according to their purpose

- **Technical cookies:** These are those that allow the user to browse through the Website and use the different options or services that are available such as, for example, control traffic and data communication, identify the type of browser, identify the session, access restricted access areas, use the services made available to the user, use security elements during navigation. These types of cookies improve the user experience by optimizing performance based on the information collected.
- **Personalization cookies:** These cookies are intended to set the basic and specific criteria of the user's terminal (language, browser type, locale of access to the service, etc.), without being used to configure a user profile.
- **Analytical cookies:** Analytical cookies collect information to evaluate the use of the Website and the general activity of the website. Web analytics is the measurement, collection, analysis and reporting of Internet data for the purpose of understanding and optimizing the use of the website. These types of cookies are used on this Website.
- **Social cookies:** Social cookies are those used by external social networks (Facebook, Google+ and Twitter). Its function is to control interaction with social widgets within the page.
- **Behavioral advertising cookies:** These are those with the ability to store data related to your browsing behavior and habits, such as your preferred destinations and activities. As a result of this storage and processing, it is possible to obtain a specific user profile that improves and gives greater efficiency to the advertising offers that are displayed during navigation.

__utma	2 years from setup/upgrade	Used to distinguish users and sessions. It is created when the javascript library runs and there are no _utma cookies. Updates each time data is sent to Google Analytics.
__utmb	30 min. From setup/update	Used to determine new sessions/visits. It is created when the javascript library runs and there are no __utbm cookies. Updates each time data is sent to Google Analytics.
__utmc	End of browser session	Not used in ga.js. Used for interoperability with urchin.js. Historically, this cookie operated in conjunction with the __utmb cookie to determine if the user was in a new session/visit.
__utmz	6 months from setup/upgrade	Stores the traffic source or campaign that explains how the user got to the web. Created when the javascript library runs and updates each time the data is sent to Google Analytics.

Why do we use Google Analytics?

Google Analytics is Google's free web analytics tool that helps website owners understand, through aggregated data, how visitors interact – without identifying them – with their website, to understand trends and ways of using the page, obtaining reports that help continuously improve pages.
